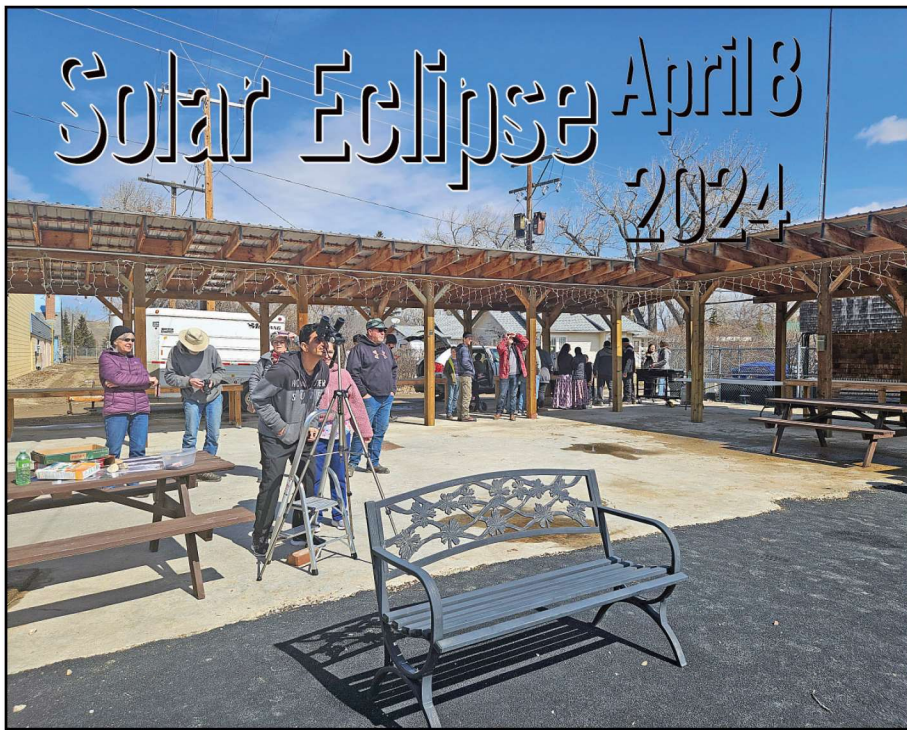

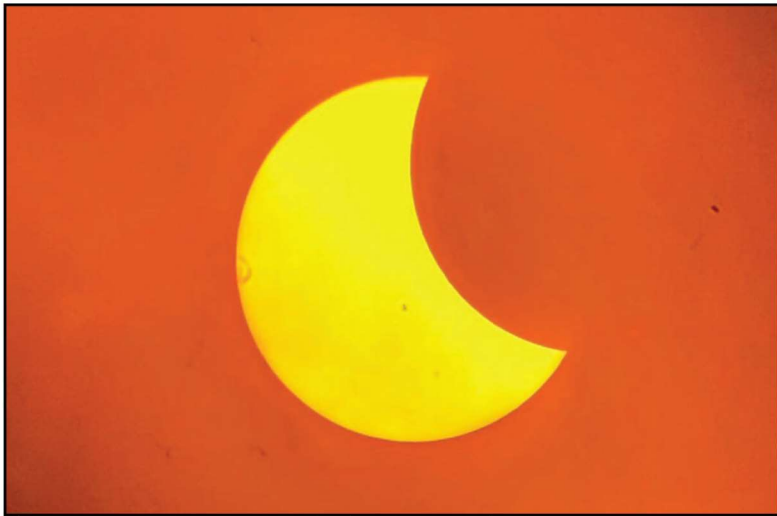

### STUDENT SUMMER EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

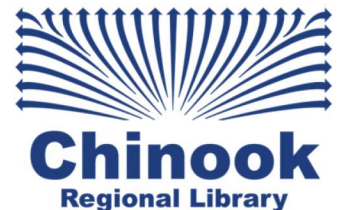
