LIBERALS WIN FEDERAL ELECTION

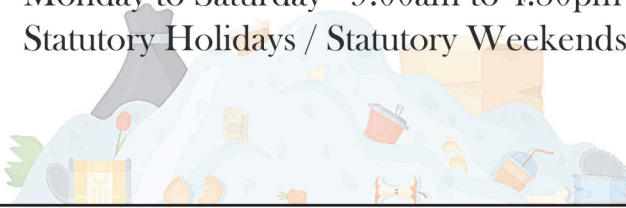

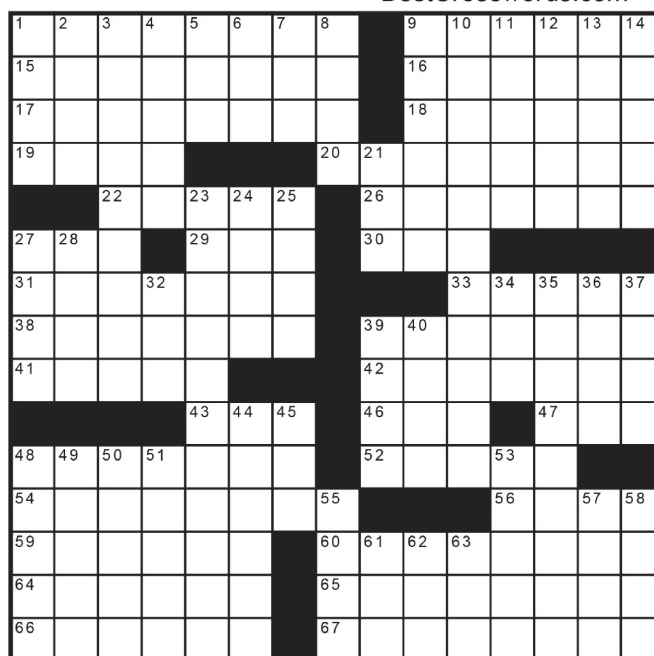
